# Written (1)

## LREC 2008 Marrakech

- ◆ evident consolidation of know-how and best practices in multilevel corpus processing/annotation and variable corpora building
- ◆ extension to new national & regional languages not sufficiently covered so far
- ◆ semantic resources, annotation and ontological engineering almost at cruising speed now (ca 60 papers at this LREC)
- ◆ considerable progress in multilingual information processing and machine translation (ca 70 papers at this LREC)



# Written (2)

## LREC 2008 Marrakech

- ◆ new areas receiving considerable attention
  - ◆ spatiotemporal annotation
  - ◆ sentiment analysis and emotion
- ◆ future challenges
  - ◆ robustness of language technology wrt user generated content in e.g. Web2.0
  - ◆ intelligent integration/interfacing of language with other media and modalities in content processing and man-machine interfaces
  - ◆ language resources and technology in cognition/perception analysis



# Written (3)

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- Multiword Expressions
  - Proper identification and treatment essential for MT, QA, IR, etc.
  - around 20 papers at LREC
  - Workshop on Sunday
  - Nevertheless, more work in this area is desirable and needed

## Tools, Platforms and Methodologies

- Important effort in the development of annotation methodologies, platforms and tools for speech and multimodal resources.
- Some thinking and some actions should be taken to standardize annotation schemes, information structure, methodologies, etc. to easily reuse and improve the already available and future resources and to guarantee the quality of the resources.



# Spoken Language Evaluation

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- **Basic reflections on evaluation principles and evaluation metrics**
- **Increasing number of languages**
  - Broadcast News
    - Czech, Khmer, Thai, Norwegian, Arabic...
    - 1 hour of speech needs 1000 working hours for phonemic transcription
- **Evaluation of more and more complex systems including SLP**
  - Speech to speech translation (in dialogs)
    - ASR + MT + TTS (+SLD)
    - Still no use of prosodics
    - Automated evaluation vs human judgment
  - Question answering on speech in meetings
    - Conversational SR + Q&A
  - Multy-party dialogs
    - Multy-party, spontaneous SR + SLD
    - Evaluation of the detection of language disfluencies
  - Historic speech collections retrieval
    - ASR + IR + UI
    - From Broadcast News to Cultural Heritage :
    - From 30% to 70 % WER : New metrics RIA (Rank Index Accuracy)
- **Evaluation campaigns or within projects**
  - Transtac, GALE, CLEF, Technolangue, STEVIN, CENSREC...
  - TC-Star, CHIL, Quaero...





# Evaluation - Written

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- **Evaluation is very important at LREC – and mirrors the field**
- Evaluation of simple components and of applications
- Semantics coming up: evaluation of semantics, senses, time etc.
- MT evaluation is developing Information extraction, IR, QA, etc. is strong and evolving
- Classification, summarisation etc.
  
- **The field is maturing, metrics become more standardized**
- **Wanted: more on metrics and methodologies – NB NIST-MATR**

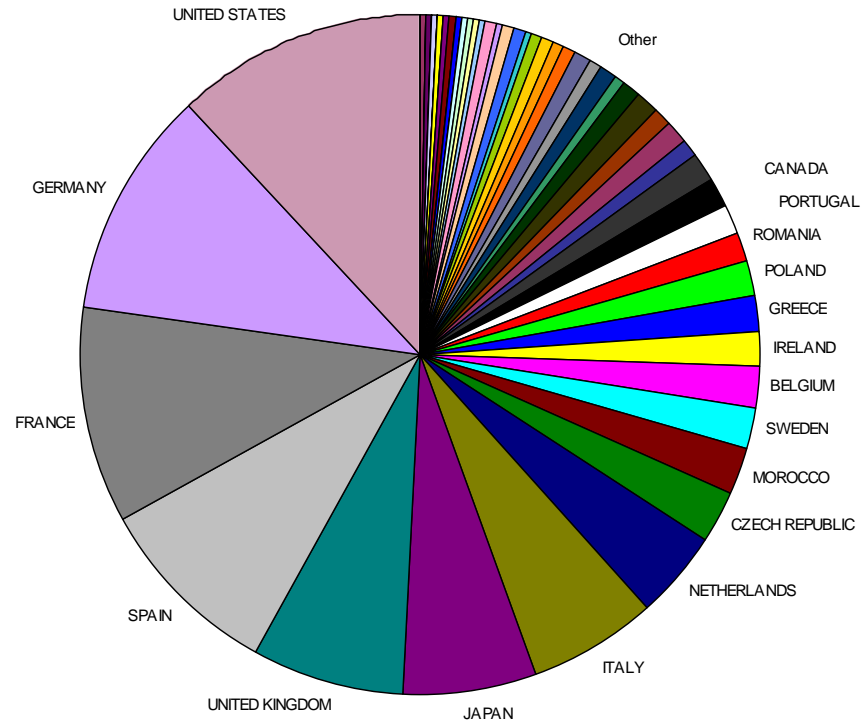
